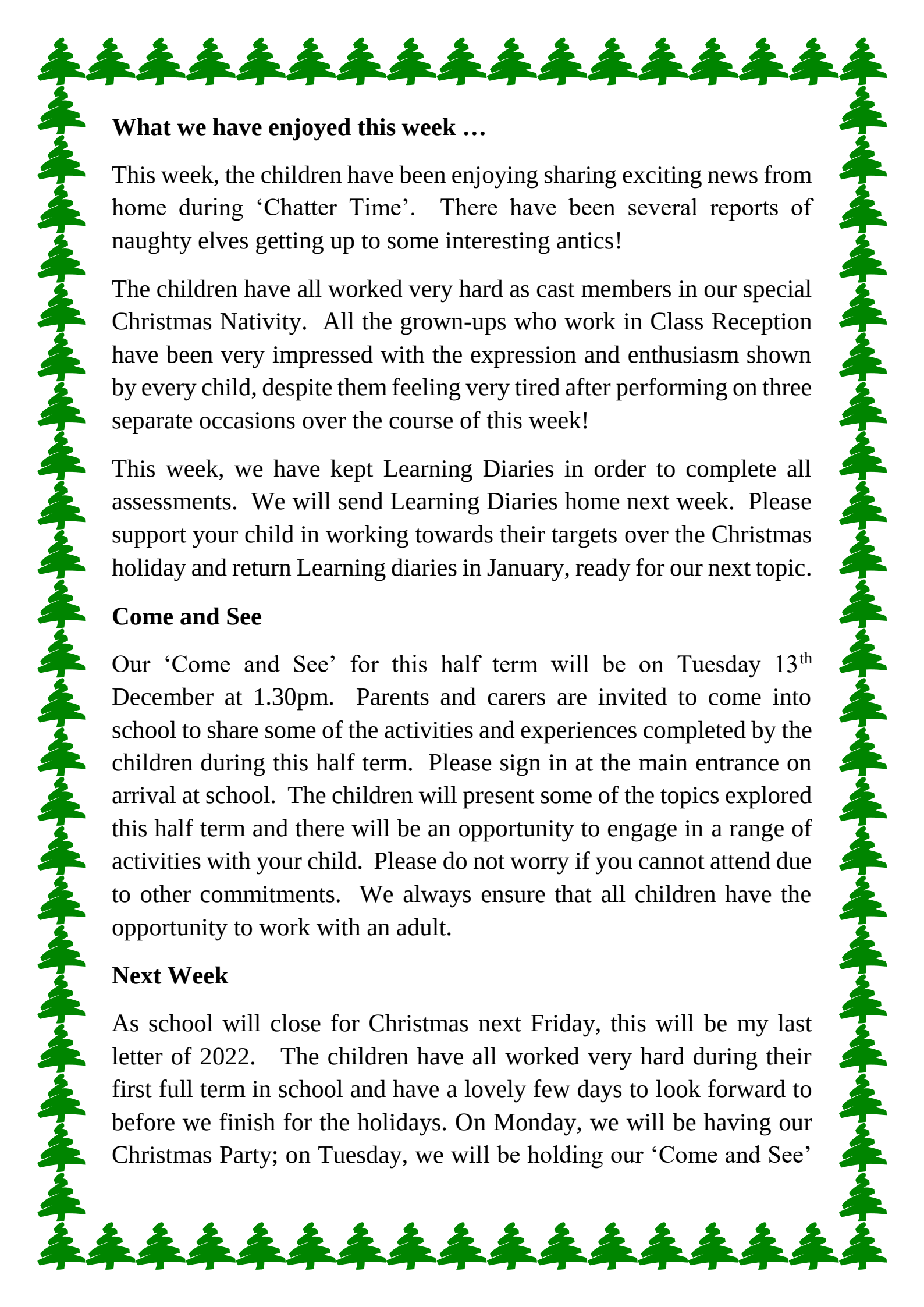




What we have enjoyed this week ...
